ENCOURAGE: IDENTIFY SOMEONE WHO NEEDS TO HEAR THE GOSPEL; IT MAY BE A FAMILY MEMBER OR A FRIEND FROM SCHOOL. MAKE AN EFFORT TO BE BOLD AND SHARE THE GOOD NEWS ABOUT JESUS WITH THEM. IT MAY BE SCARY IN THE MOMENT BUT REMEMBER THAT JESUS COMMANDS US TO TELL OTHERS THE GOOD NEWS AND MAKE THEM DISCIPLES FOR THE KINGDOM AS HE TOLD THE DISCIPLES IN MATTHEW 28:18-20.
